

Energy Reduction Policy

The aim of this policy is to support energy efficiency initiatives and encourage actions that reduce our energy consumption. The steps outlined in this policy will be implemented in a proactive and forward-thinking manner to ensure that our operations remain energy-efficient, responsible, and cost-effective. By reducing our energy use, we aim to contribute to a more sustainable future and reduce our carbon footprint.

Whenever possible, all staff—including directors, managers, and employees—are expected to follow these guidelines:

- Comply with international and national laws, regulations, and standards related to energy use and conservation.
- Communicate this policy to suppliers and staff at all levels to raise awareness and foster a culture of energy conservation.
- **Set clear objectives and targets** for energy reduction, along with key performance indicators to track progress.
- Regularly monitor and evaluate energy consumption through the use of tracking systems.
- **Train employees** on our environmental commitments and provide guidance on energy-saving practices.
- Reduce operating costs by identifying and implementing energy-efficient measures.
- **Take responsibility for energy use** in individual workspaces, including switching off computers, laptops, and other office equipment when not in use.
- Unplug all electrical equipment and turn off power sockets after office hours.
- Continue using energy-efficient LED lighting to minimize energy consumption.
- Adopt sustainable web browsers like Eco-Asia to reduce digital energy usage.
- **Educate travelers** by sharing information on energy-saving practices and encouraging them to adopt sustainable habits while on tour.
