

Water Reduction Policy

At **Adventure International Trekking**, our water reduction policy is a key part of our commitment to sustainability. We take several proactive steps to ensure water is used responsibly and efficiently in our operations. The aim of this policy is to lower our water consumption, thus helping preserve this critical resource under increasing pressure.

This policy describes the measures we will implement to achieve water reduction goals, including conducting water audits, establishing clear targets, adopting water-efficient practices, encouraging sustainable habits among employees and clients, and engaging with suppliers to promote water conservation. These actions are carried out in a proactive and progressive manner to ensure that water use remains both responsible and cost-effective.

Whenever possible, all staff—including directors, managers, and employees—are expected to adhere to the following principles:

- Comply with all relevant international and national laws, guidelines, and standards.
- Share this policy with suppliers and employees at every level to raise awareness.
- Set objectives, targets, and performance indicators for water conservation.
- Regularly monitor and evaluate water consumption through a tracking system.
- Educate staff on water-saving practices and encourage them to adopt these habits at work and in their personal lives.
- Conduct bi-monthly checks to identify and fix leaks or unusual water usage.
- Use water responsibly through best practice maintenance and cleaning procedures.
- Inform clients in advance about potential water scarcity in rural parts of Nepal, and advise them to use water sparingly during their stay.

Adventure International Trekking will review and update this policy periodically—at least once every two years—to ensure it remains relevant and effective.
